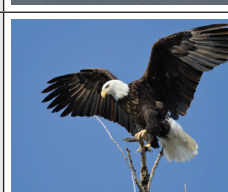
10. Dolphins are aquatic mammals. They are intelligent and friendly. They live in groups and make sounds to communicate with each other. They feed on fish.
