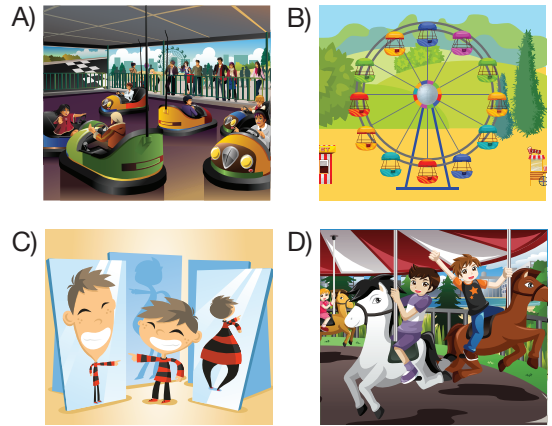
**THE FANTASTIC FUNFAIR**

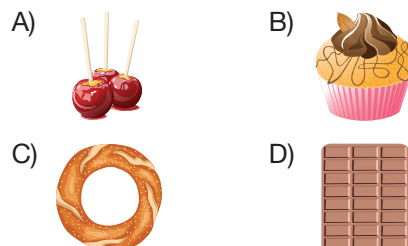

Which of the following activities CANNOT she do at the playground?

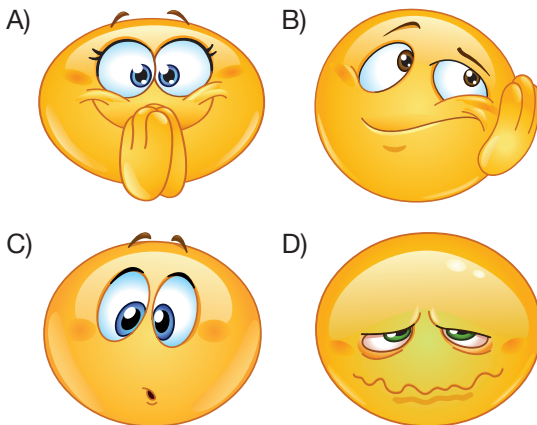
