

Most of the teens (45%) believe social media has a neither positive nor negative effect on people. Meanwhile, about three-in-ten teens (31%) say social media has had a mostly positive impact, while 24% describe its effect as mostly negative.


Some of the teens think that social media has mostly positive effect because it provides connectivity and connection with others. 40% of these teens said that social media has a positive impact because it helps them to keep in touch and interact with others. Others in this group cite the greater access to news and information that social media facilitates (16%), or being able to connect with people who share similar interests (15%)

Smaller shares argue that social media is a good place for entertainment (9%), that it offers a space for self-expression (7%) or that it allows teens to get support from others (5%) or to learn new things in general (4%).

Another 12% criticize social media for influencing teens to give in to peer pressure, while smaller shares express concerns that these sites could lead to psychological issues or drama.

BASIC FRENCH OMELET RECIPE	STEP 1	BEAT eggs, water, salt and pepper in small bowl until blended.

1/8 Salt		and gently moving cooked portions as needed.
Dash pepper		
1 tsp butter	STEP 4	When top surface of eggs is thickened and no visible
1/3 filling		liquid egg remains, PLACE filling on one side of the omelet. FOLD omelet in half with turner. With a quick flip of the wrist, turn pan and INVERT or SLIDE omelet onto plate. SERVE immediately.
